

Totem Sculpture Making Project Open Call for Environmental Arts Proposal

In 2008, CLP Power Hong Kong Limited (CLP) and Hong Kong Youth Arts Foundation (HKYAF) initiated an arts education project to help raise public awareness in the areas of recycling, energy consumption and nature preservation. 400 primary school students from 4 primary schools participated in an artist-in-residence programme over a 3 month period to decorate 8 feet high totem poles. These totem poles express a commitment from the schools and their students to environmental protection.



CLP and YAF will organize another totem sculpture making project to benefit another 4 schools and their students. Through the art creation process, the students will be encouraged to learn more about nature and what we can do to protect our environment.

Now we are inviting your school to submit a proposal to apply for a free artist-in-residence programme. 4 schools selected by CLP will be provided 6-8 artist-led workshop sessions, the totem pole basic structure and a material subsidy to create the life-size sculpture. This totem pole will be a visual statement to represent the school's and their students' commitment to environmental protection.

If your school is interested in this project, please fill in the application form with a design layout and submit it to YAF by post or via email before 20 Oct, 2008.

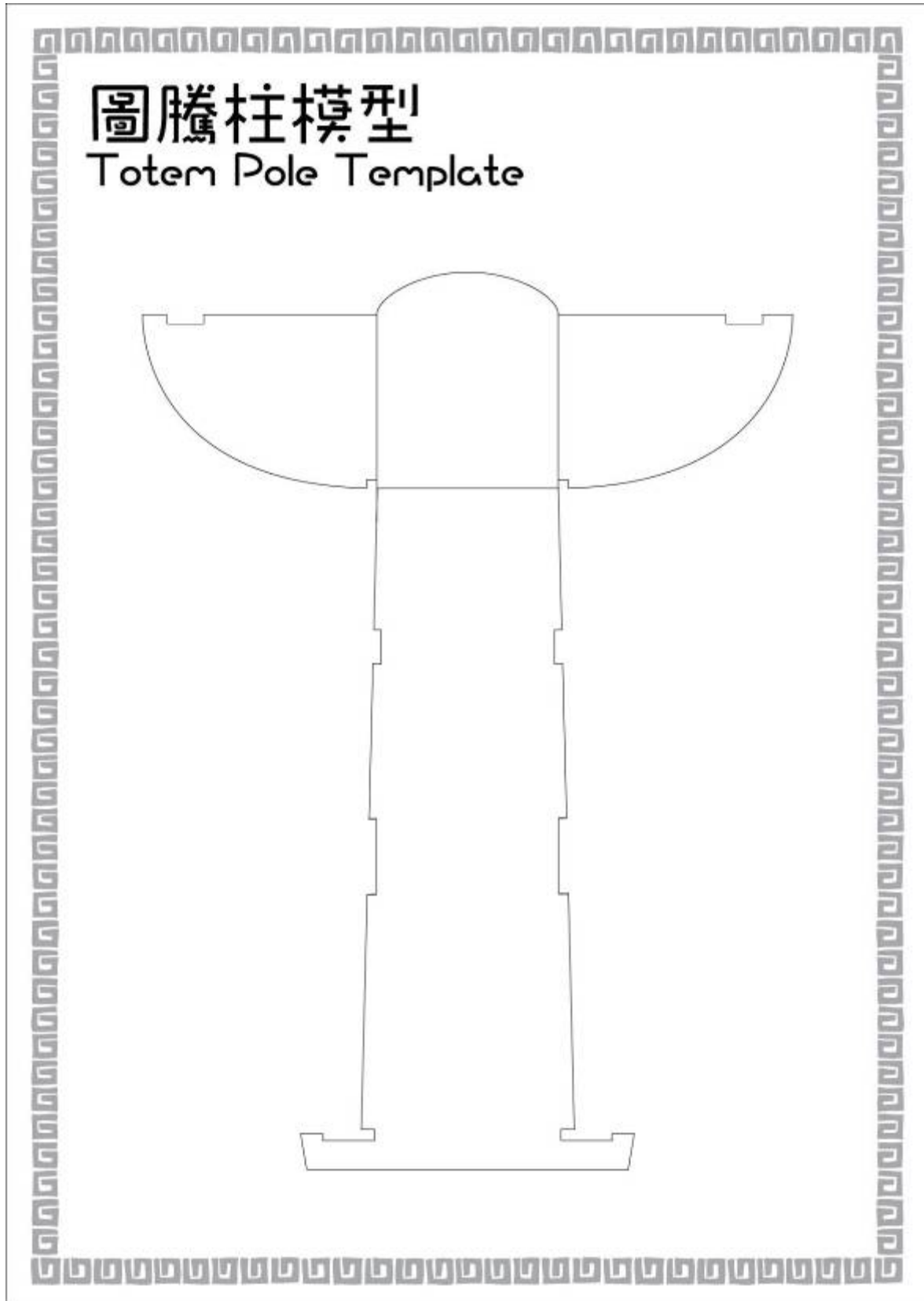
